These along with the development of preventive steps and blueprint for healthcare technology have propelled the subject of healthcare into one of the vital national projects in countries not just in Asia but worldwide.

Asia's healthcare market will continue to grow exponentially and this is spearheaded by a number of distinct factors. The buoyant medical tourism market in Asia has provided the impetus for hospitals and healthcare establishments to compete for the medical tourism pie projected to be valued at US\$4.4 billion by 2012. Additionally, the reconstruction and construction, re-equipping of existing medical establishments with new devices are contributing to the urgent need for more sophisticated medical equipment, hardware and software.
