OS+H Asia 2010 attracts diversity of international exhibitors

- **Leading consultants to provide timely advice against backdrop of government OSH initiatives**

The countdown to **OS+H Asia 2010** is closing in and all indications are that OS+H Asia 2010 will once again prove to be the definitive event of its kind in the Southeast Asia region come 15 to 17 September 2010 when the doors open at Suntec Singapore.
