#### **OS+H Asia 2010: Playing a key role in an increasingly important sector in the ASEAN region**

- **Visitor pre-registrations up 40%**
- **5,000 trade visitors anticipated**
- **Comprehensive show exhibits and live demonstrations reflect ongoing and emerging needs of end users**

As the countdown to opening day of **OS+H Asia 2010** gains momentum, the role of the event in promoting occupational safety and health in ASEAN is becoming all the more relevant given the increased emphasis that various industries and governments throughout the region are placing on these issues. More and more, companies are realizing that appropriate OSH strategies contribute to the bottom line and they are working hand-in-hand with governmental and other relevant organizations to implement them.

“Singapore aims to play a lead role in the ASEAN region when it comes to occupational safety and health issues and **OS+H Asia** is playing a key support role in achieving this objective,” says Mr. Gernot Ringling, Managing Director of show organizer Messe Düsseldorf Asia. “**OS+H Asia 2010** has continued to grow in sync with the increased prominence of occupational safety and health in the region and when combined with the co-located Singapore WSH Conference and Forum on Safety & Health, it has developed into an important event on the regional OSH calendar.”

Reflecting this enhanced status, this year the organizers report visitor pre-registration to be up 40% compared with the last edition of the show, while they anticipate visitors from more than 40 countries based on these pre-registrations. An estimated 5,000 trade professionals are expected over the duration of the show and they will be availed of a cross-section of exhibits reflecting the current and future needs of the industry. Says Ringling, “The success of **OS+H Asia 2010** will definitely play its part in an underlying role aligned with Singapore’s aspirations to become an occupation safety and health hub.”

## **A comprehensive display**

Since its inception twelve years ago, **OS+H Asia 2010** has grown and developed parallel with this increased importance attached to safety and health issues and with a make-up of exhibits that accurately reflect the needs of end users of OSH products and solutions in the region, the show is poised for yet another successful staging. Of particular note is the highly diverse array of products that will be highlighted from key sub-segments of occupational safety and health such as Environment Control; Fire Protection Products & Services; Personal Safety Equipment; Workplace Ergonomics; Safety Equipment & Safe Facilities; Work Safety in High Risk Areas; Industrial Medicine, First Aid & Hygiene; and Safe Handling of Dangerous Substances

Besides a comprehensive display of products and solutions, exhibitors at **OS+H Asia 2010** will also stage a series of live demonstrations including "Gotcha The Original Rescue Kit" by QMT Industrial and Safety Pte Ltd., "Work Smarter to Increase Productivity & Safety with MEWPs (LiftPod & 1930ES Scissor Lift)" by Galmon (Singapore) Pte Ltd., and "The New Data Logger" by Loads Controls Systems Pte Ltd.
