VIETNAM AND CAMBODIA DISCOVERY : 7 DAYS / 6 NIGHTS TRAVEL PACKAGE

ITINERARY:

Day 1: Hanoi – Arrival (Lunch, Dinner)

Pick up at the Noi Bai airport and transfer to the hotel in Hanoi. You will join a half-day city tour and visit the Temple of Literature, the Temple of the Jade Emperor and the art museum. In the afternoon, enjoy a traditional folk show and an ancient traditional water puppet show. Overnight in Hanoi, Vietnam's capital city

Day 2: Hanoi – Halong Bay- Hanoi (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

In the morning, transfer with guide to Ha long City (170km). Upon arrival, board a private boat for a stunning cruise in Ha long Bay (4 hours) a World Heritage site recognized by UNESCO. Visit some magical grottoes while relaxing in the best scenic beauty of Vietnam. Enjoy a traditional lunch with the freshest and finest seafood. Return to Hanoi in the afternoon by bus and overnight in Hanoi.

Day 3: Hanoi – Saigon (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

Transfer to the airport for a 2-hour flight to Saigon. Pick up at the airport and transfer to the hotel in Saigon. The half day city tour will take you around the city, from downtown Saigon to Chinatown, in order to get a general view of a developing city. See places of interests such as Notre Dame Cathedral, The Central Post Office and Reunification Hall. Visit the Thien Hau pagoda and the bustling Chinese district. Overnight in Saigon

Day 4: Saigon (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

After having breakfast, you are free or explore Saigon at your own pace. In the afternoon, enjoy shopping at the bursting Ben Thanh market and at other well know retailers for bargain like shopping activities. In the evening, enjoy a dinner on board a cruise boat on the Saigon River. Overnight in Saigon

Day 5: Saigon – Siem Reap (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

Transfer to the airport for a flight to Siem Reap. Upon arrival at Siem Reap airport, you'll be met by your guide and transferred to the hotel. In the afternoon, enjoy an excursion to Banteay Srei, which dates back to 967 AD. The temple is dedicated to the Hindu god Shiva and famed for the intricate friezes carved into its red sandstone walls. On the way back, we will visit Banteay Samre built during Suryarvaman II's rule in the middle of the 12th century. Next on the itinerary are three impressive temples from the 10th century – Eastern Mebon, Pre Rup and Prasat Kravan. Explore the intricate and ingenious designs. The first day concludes with panoramic views of the sunset and Angkor Wat from temple mountain Phnom Bakhaeng (900 AD). Overnight in Siem Reap.

Day 6: Angkor & Siem Reap (Breakfast, Lunch, Dinner)

After breakfast, you will visit to the awe-inspiring Angkor Thom or 'Great City' and many of the finest Temples of King Jayavarman VII, who ruled from 1181-1220. At the southern gate of Angkor Thom, you will marvel at the imposing 23-metre high stone faces of Avalokiteshvara, which was featured in the Tomb Raider movie. At the centre of this citadel lies the state temple of Bayon. This temple-mountain, built at the end of the 12th century, is adorned with hundreds of gigantic stone faces. Tour includes the Terrace of Elephants, the Terrace of the Leper King and the 12 identical towers of Prasat Suor Prat. Later in the day you will discover the most famous temples from the 11th century: Baphuon, Phimeanakas, North Khleang and South Khleang. In the afternoon we will begin our exploration of the magnificent Angkor Wat, built under Suryavarman II, and the Ta Prohm complex dating back to Jayavarman VII's reign (1181-1220). The evening is given over to entertainment – a visit to the Apsara Theatre to enjoy a fine Khmer dinner and traditional dances. Overnight in Siem Reap.

Day 7: Siem Reap- Departure (Breakfast)

On the third and final day, we will spend the morning visiting other important temples of Jayavarman VII: Preah Khan, Neak Pean, Ta Prom. This will be followed by transfer to the airport for your return flight.
