CIOSH THAILAND 2024: First edition concludes on a high note as sourcing platform for PPE innovation

Singapore – 13 June 2024 – CIOSH THAILAND, the only specialist trade exhibition dedicated to PPE (Personal Protective Equipment) in Southeast Asia, successfully concluded its first iteration last week at BITEC, Bangkok. Closing on a highly positive and optimistic note, CIOSH THAILAND welcomed 3,117 trade visitors and industry professionals, with the international share of visitors comprising close to 20% from 20 countries, including Laos, Indonesia, Malaysia, Philippines, and Singapore.
