T-PLAS 2023: Successful conclusion at BITEC

Leading manufacturer and distributor of research, analytical and process analysis instruments Bruker Optics, **Dr. Sirinnapa (Mui) Saranwong, Business Development and Key Account Manager for SEA,** said: "We did get exposure to new customers in several industries, so it has been worthwhile for us especially considering the high-quality visitors. The visitors are really looking for solutions."
